Points System

- Points will be accumulated from county activities from Jan. 1, 2025, through Dec. 31, 2025.
- All 2025 activities must be reported to IPPA by Nov. 30, 2025.
- County activities not listed but submitted will be considered for points final determination will be made by IPPA committee.
